Dear Parent/Carer,

Update on Return to School In January 2021

I write to update you on the situation for returning to school following the Christmas and New Year Holidays.

As things stand currently, **secondary schools** are still being asked to stagger the return of students from January 4th 2021, whilst **Primary Schools** are due to return as normal at the start of term.

It continues to be the case that students with EHCP's, students who have critical worker parents/carers and **all special schools** are being asked to open as normal from the start of term.

Therefore, as things stand at the moment, **New Forest School will open as planned** after the Christmas break:

Monday 4th January: INSET day

Tuesday 5th January: All students return to school

As always, should anything change before January 5th I will of course contact all parents/carers and update you.

Update on COVID-19 Testing of Students/Staff

It continues to be the case that schools are being strongly encouraged to develop and run a programme of **asymptomatic lateral flow testing**.

These tests are optional and require either consent from the parent/carer for students or consent from staff members to be tested.

Those students/staff **who do not choose to participate** in the testing programme would need to self-isolate for 10 days if they have close contact with a positive case as we have been through last term.
