

## NEW FOREST SCHOOL: SENCO REPORT

Creating an inclusive environment is the most important aim at New Forest School. We aim to bring to our student's a sense of happiness, a feeling of safety and most importantly, being a part of the wider community.

Currently we have 64 children on roll, all of which are in receipt of an EHCP, it is important to note that students with the same diagnosis, can have very different educational needs. Jean Gammon and Jenna Warbrick are Senco's responsible for ensuring the correct SEND support is in place and monitoring every student's progress in line with their identified outcomes. The focus is always to improve outcomes for our students, and giving them access to rich and positive experiences.

### **Intervention and Training**

29/06/2022 KS2 staff attended twilight training session in dyslexia, presented by Lucy Manger. EP

The touch typing programme introduced last year has been embraced by our KS2 students, and has been rolled out across the Key stages, it has been a valuable resource in encouraging our students in becoming more adept at recording work, and engaging in formal writing tasks

Emotional Wellbeing meetings continue every Thursday to discuss intervention and share strategies, Jenna Warbrick Deputy SENCO, Sian Plummer MHN, Sam Briggs and Crystal Hawkhead Therapists are in attendance, as well as Christopher Kelly (Post 16). These meetings are pivotal in discussing interventions, therapy and social, emotional or mental health issues.

EP/SALT and OT assessments have been completed for all new students arriving at the school this summer and reports shared with staff and professionals

### **Exam Prep and Special Considerations**

Special considerations were applied for successfully for students, extra time and using PC where appropriate. JCQ inspectors thoroughly checked process in on site visit and satisfied procedures were adhered to professionally.

### **Staff Resources**

We have three fully trained ELSA's in school, all who have completed the Hampshire training. Teachers and SENCO's will now refer students for 6 week programmes as required, as well as group work, and of course individual time for those in need.
